

PRAYERS AND RESPONSES
AT OUR EUCHARTISTIC CELEBRATION

Priest: In the name of the Father and of the Son and of the Holy Spirit

Rx: Amen

Priest: The Lord be with you.

Rx: And with your spirit

Priest: (A) The grace of our Lord Jesus Christ, and the love of God and the communion of the Holy Spirit be with you all. (*Amen*)

or

Priest (B) Grace to you and peace from God our Father and the Lord Jesus Christ. (*Amen*)

PENITENTIAL RITE The Confiteor

I confess to Almighty God, and to you, my brothers and sisters, that I have greatly sinned in my thoughts and in my words, in what I have done and in what I failed to do, through my fault, through my fault, through my most grievous fault; therefore I ask Blessed Mary, ever-virgin, all the angels and saints and to you, my brother and sisters, to pray for me to the Lord, our God.

or

Priest: Have mercy on us, O Lord.

Rx: For we have sinned against you.

Priest: Show us O Lord your mercy.

Rx: And grant us your salvation

or

.....Lord, Have Mercy..... **Rx:** Lord Have Mercy

.....Christ, Have Mercy..... **Rx:** Christ, Have Mercy.....

.....Lord, Have Mercy..... **Rx:** Lord, Have Mercy.....

Priest: May Almighty God, have mercy us, forgive us our sins and bring us to everlasting life.

Rx: Amen

GLORIA (ALL)

Glory to God in the highest, and on earth peace to people of good will. We praise you, we bless you, we adore you, we glorify you, we give you thanks for your great glory, Lord God, heavenly King, O God Almighty Father.

Lord Jesus Christ, Only begotten Son, Lord God, Lamb of God, Son of the Father, you take away the sins of the world, have mercy on us; you take away the sins of the world, receive our prayer; you are seated at the right hand of the Father, have mercy on us. For you alone are the Holy One, you alone are the Lord, you alone are the Most High, Jesus Christ, with the Holy Spirit, in the glory of God the Father. Amen

SCRIPTURE:

After the Old Testament – 1st Reading

Rx: Thanks be to God!

After the New Testament – 2nd Reading

Rx: Thanks be to God!

GOSPEL

***Priest:* The Lord be with you**

Rx: And with your spirit

***Priest:* A reading from the Holy Gospel according to ...**

Rx: Glory to you, O Lord.

(A small sign of the cross is made on the forehead, lips and the heart)

After the Gospel reading.....

Rx: Praise to you, Lord Jesus Christ.

CREED (ALL)

I believe in one God, the Father the Almighty, maker of heaven and earth, of all things visible and invisible.

I believe in one Lord Jesus Christ, the only begotten Son of God, born of the Father before all ages. God from God, Light from Light, true God from true God, begotten, not made, consubstantial with the Father; through him all things were made. For us men and for

our salvation he came down from heaven, and by the Holy Spirit, was incarnate of the virgin Mary, and became man. (bow)
For our sake he was crucified under Pontius Pilate, he suffered death and was buried, and rose again on the third day in accordance with the Scriptures. He ascended into heaven and is seated at the right hand of the Father. He will come again in glory to judge the living and the dead and his kingdom will have no end.
I believe in the Holy Spirit, the Lord, the giver of life, who proceeds from the Father and the Son, who with the Father and the Son is adored and glorified, who spoke through the prophets. I believe in one, holy, Catholic and apostolic Church. I confess one baptism for the forgiveness of sins and I look forward to the resurrection of the dead and the life of the world to come. Amen

Rx: May the Lord accept the sacrifice at your hands for the praise and glory of his name, for our good and the good of all his holy Church.

PREFACE

Priest: The Lord be with you.

Rx: And with your spirit

Priest: Lift up your hearts

Rx: We have lifted them up to the Lord.

Priest: Let us give thanks to the Lord God

Rx: It is right and just.

Priest: All powerful and ever living God.....

Rx: Holy, Holy, Holy. Lord God of hosts.

Heaven and earth are filled with your glory.

Hosanna in the highest. Blessed is he who comes in the name of the Lord. Hosanna in the highest.

MEMORIAL ACCLAIMATION (Response - One of the following)

- 1. We proclaim your death, O Lord, and profess your Resurrection until you come again.**
- 2. When we eat this bread and drink this cup, we proclaim your Death, O Lord, until you come again.**
- 3. Save us, Savior of the world, for by your Cross and Resurrection, you have set us free.**

OUR FATHER.....

LAMB OF GOD

Priest: Behold, the Lamb of God, behold him who takes away the sin of the world. Blessed are those called to the supper of the Lamb.

Rx: **Lord, I am not worthy that you should enter under my roof, but only say the word and my soul shall be healed.**

(Deacon) *or*

(B) Go and announce the Gospel of the Lord.

or

(C) Go in peace glorifying the Lord by your life.

(D) Go in peace
