OVERVIEW OF PARISH ARTICLES FOR THE BULLETIN: The schedule of topics for the bulletin inserts was distributed to the committee.

SCHEDULE FOR LEARNING MASS PARTS TO BE SUNG: The following schedule was decided for all three weekend Masses:

- Rehearse refrain of *Glory to God* with congregation October 8-9, 15-16, and briefly 22-23. Begin using *Glory to God* at Mass on October 22-23.
- Rehearse chant for *Holy, Holy* on October 22-23, 29-30, November 5-6, and briefly on November 12-13. Begin using chant *Holy* at Mass on November 12-13.
- Rehearse *Memorial Acclamation* on November 12-13 and 19-20. Begin using the chant *Memorial Acclamation* on November 26-27.
- Note: Once the refrain/chant has begun being sung at Mass, it will continue for each Liturgy thereafter.
- There is no *Glory to God* during Advent.

LITURGICAL TRAINING: Judy gave an overview of how many new Liturgical ministers were trained at the last session from grades 6-7-8. The plan now is to involve all 6-7-8 graders in ministry and move Confirmation from 6th to 7th grade.

2012 CALENDAR: It was decided that the 2012 calendar be ordered from Halloran & Son. It is a stewardship calendar. 400 copies have been ordered. It will be ready for distribution the last week of December.

ALL SAINTS' DAY: Mass will be celebrated at 9:00 and 7:30. Jane will play at the 9:00 Mass. Celeste will lead at the 7:30 Mass but proposed that all music ministers be invited to join her.

MASSES OF REMEMBRANCE: This has been scheduled for the weekend of November 5-6. It was decided that after a set of ten names are read, the congregation will sing the response from *Shepherd Me, O God*.

ACTION: Janet Lavelle has the form letter and only needs to make necessary adjustments. Dee will contact Janet.

Celeste will ask Chris or Marilyn at the staff meeting if one of them could be responsible to mail out the letters. Dee and Joanne offered to help, if needed.

Celeste will also ask Chris to notify sacristans about the sung response. The letters will go out the week of October 17.

There will be a bulletin article and announcement made about the remembrance service at all weekend Masses on October 22-23, and 29-30.

Celeste suggested that an announcement be made at these Masses, too, about the significance of the flowers that are placed beside the tabernacle from funeral Masses.

SCC MATERIAL: It was suggested that a Bible study surrounding a book be done in lieu of SCC. It will be scheduled during Lent. Judy, Joanne, Bruce, and Jane volunteered to serve as coordinators.

ADVENT MATERIAL: Materials for review were distributed. Joanne shared ideas from a passage she read by Kathleen Durkin in which the idea of a multi-paned window is used as an image. The committee will review all the materials for further discussion at next month's meeting.

THANKSGIVING: Mass will be celebrated at 9:00. Bags of food will again be offered by the congregation.

ADVENT CHORAL: The program has been scheduled for December 4.

IMMACULATE CONCEPTION: The anticipatory Mass will be celebrated at 7:30. Patty will lead the music. The two Masses on December 8 are at 9:00 and 7:30. Jane will play at 9:00 and the choir will sing at 7:30.

VETERANS' DAY: All veterans will get a blessing at the Masses the weekend of November 12-13.

RCIA: There is currently one person in the program. The Rite of Acceptance will be at the 9:00 Mass on November 20. The first dismissal will also be at this Liturgy after the homily.

They will not be meeting on November 28, December 18, or December 25. The program will resume on January 8.
