

**St. Christopher's
Green Autumn Harvest Raffle
Questions & Answers**

1) Can I re-sell my ticket?

No. The tickets are sold by St. Christopher's to a specific person. They may not be re-sold.

2) I've submitted my order. Where is my raffle ticket?

You will not receive an actual ticket; once your order is received by St. Christopher's Church, a confirmation letter will be sent to the buyer's address via US Mail. The actual "ticket" is generated and placed in the drawing.

3) I lost my confirmation letter. Can I still win?

Yes. If your ticket is drawn as a winner, you will be notified.

4) Who can be designated as the "seller" on the order form?

The seller can be any registered member of St. Christopher's Church who is 18 years of age or older. The seller information on the order form is optional and can be left blank. However, if you qualify as a seller, you are encouraged to complete the seller information on the order form so that you have an opportunity to win various awards given to ticket sellers throughout the raffle process.

5) Who can be designated as the "buyer" on the order form?

The buyer can be any individual who is 18 years of age or older.

6) Can the "buyer" and "seller" be the same person?

Yes, as long as that person is a registered member of St. Christopher's Church.

7) Can I put my child's name or grandchild's name on the order form as a buyer?

Raffle tickets make great gifts... especially if they're winners! However, the name on the ticket must be a person who is at least 18 years old.

8) My wife and I would like to purchase one or more tickets and put both our names as the buyer. Is that acceptable?

No. Only one individual can be designated as a buyer.

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9) How can I turn in my order form?

We strongly encourage order forms to be turned in at any of our after-mass selling events that will be held at various times during the raffle selling period. This will help to avoid any delays in processing your request. For those situations when no after-mass selling is taking place, you may also return your order form and payment in any of these other methods:

a) By US Mail to:

c) By placing the order form and payment in a sealed envelope, marked "Raffle" and placing the envelope in one of the mass collections

10) How can I pay for my ticket?

Ticket orders can be paid for by cash, or by cashier's check, money order or personal check made out to: St. Christopher's Church

11) How is the weekly seller determined?

The individual who sells the highest number of tickets, based on the confirmations that are processed each Friday through Thursday of a given week, is awarded the highest weekly seller prize for the following weekend. In the event there is a tie, a random drawing will determine the winner.

12) How will I know if I won the highest weekly seller prize?

Announcements will be made at each mass. In addition, the winner will be contacted via the seller information listed on the order form to learn of the good news.

13) How can the highest weekly seller claim their prize?

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In most cases, the prize will be mailed to the winner (using the seller information provided on the order form.) A few of the prizes must be picked up at the rectory; winners may call Marilyn Weinert at 594-1400 to arrange a convenient time.
